## Sir Matthew William Thompson

K Matthew William was born in 1820

He lived at Parkgate, Guiseley

He became the owner of the Bradford Brewery and a key player in the Bradford Textile Trade.



He was Lord Mayor of Bradford

Matthew William played a huge part in the Guiseley community where he lived - he paid for street Gas lighting to be installed, a new organ for St Oswald's Church, and most of the cost of building Guiseley Town Hall (now Guiseley Theatre.) He also founded Guiseley Brass Band, paying for uniforms and instruments.

He was Director of the Midland Railway Company and advocated for the building of the 'Forth Brisge' in Scotland. He also was the first person to drive a train across the bridge.

Sir Matthew died suddenly in 1891, and after a service at Esholt, was buried in St Oswald's Church Yard where his grave can still be seen today.
